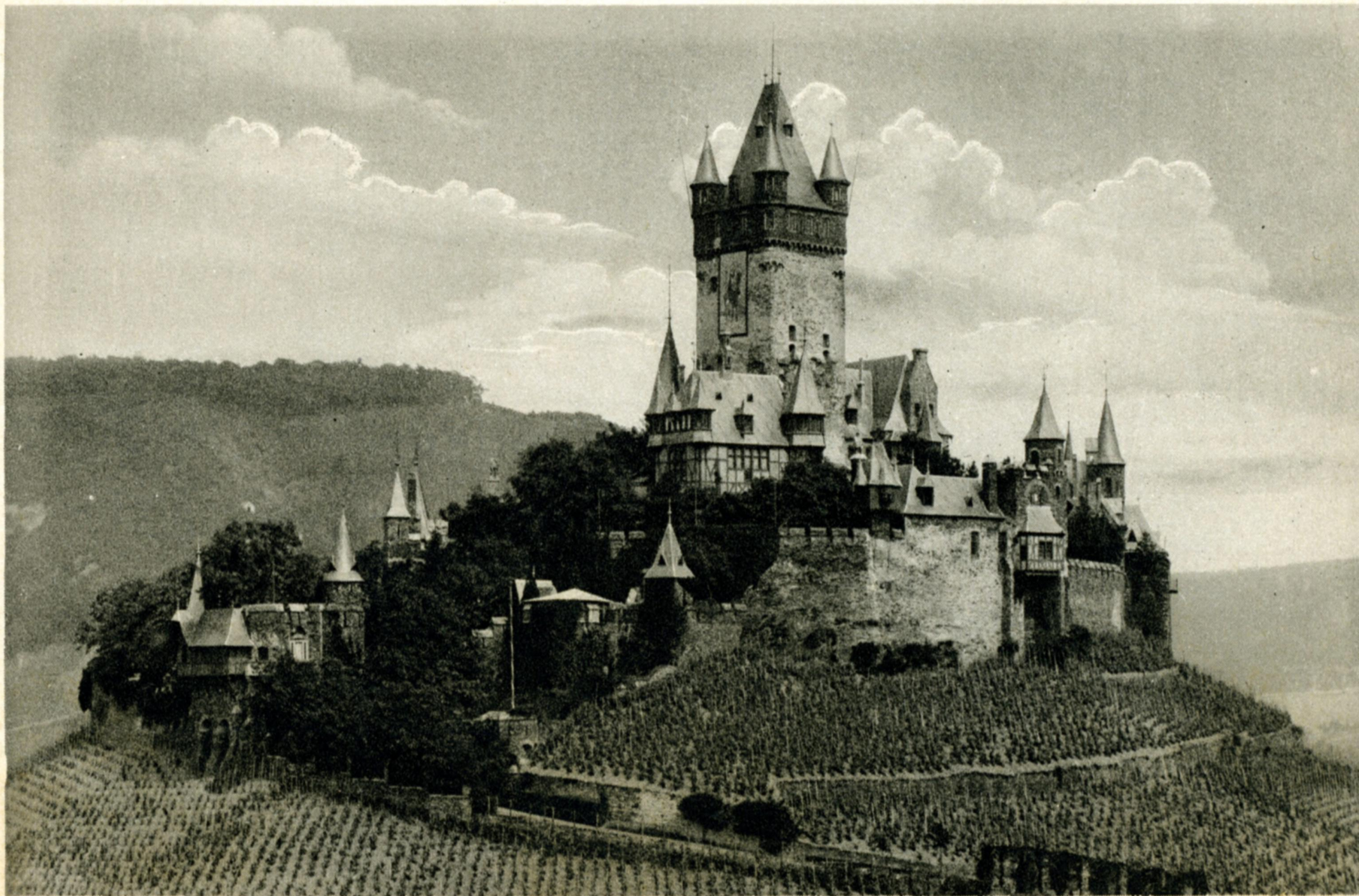

return.

16 patients in this ward from
Colonel on down to shave
tails. I will write a letter
