# Know all Men, by these Presents, That I, Robert W Ineas of the Country of Fayelle and State of Kentucky, for and in consideration of the sum of Cook Hundred Dollers current money of Kentucky, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have this day bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto & Moreley of Holly Springs, and State of Mil , a certain NEGRO B SLAVE, named In our Tien, about years of age, of a Brown complexion; which Negro I warrant sound, both in body and mind, and a Slave for life; and the title do and will forever warrant and defend, by these presents.
