Know all Men, by these Presents,

That I, *Robert W Lucas* of the County of *Fayette* and State of Kentucky, for and in consideration of the sum of *Eight Hundred Dollars* current money of Kentucky, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have this day bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto *G A Moseler* ~~of the County~~ of *Holly Springs*, and State of *Miss*, a certain NEGRO *Boy* SLAVE, named *Master*, about *Two* years of age, of a *Brown* complexion; which Negro I warrant sound, both in body and mind, and a Slave for life; and the title do and will forever warrant and defend, by these presents.
