& fifty Dollars I have this day sold to
George H. Mosely a negro boy named Tom
of dark Copper color aged twenty one year
I warrant the said boy to be sound & healthy
& slave for life. I also warrant the Title
to the said boy & hereby vest the same
in the said Mosely his heirs & assigns
Witness my hand & Seal this 1st day of
February 1857.
