and fifty dollars paid to me in hand I have  
this day bargained and sold to J. G. & S. A  
Sprockels one negro man by the name  
Evan about 14 or 20 years of age of brown  
skin I warrant the title to the said  
Sprockels against the claim of all  
others I also warrant him sound  
in body and mind and a slave  
for life
