Leamington N.Y. Feb. 18. 1852

For and in consideration of eight hundred dollars paid to me in hand I have this day bargained and sold to Mosely & Cummings our negro boy about twenty one years of age by the name of Lewis a rich boy I warrant to be sound in body and mind and the title to said boy I warrant to the said Mosely & Cummings against the claim or claims of all other persons
