Memphis May 26th 1865

Father Dear Sir

I find it impossible to make the buying arrangement, talked of - on your terms.

You can buy any amount you want, on 60 or 90 days time, that is the best that can be done now. & I fear you would not

be able to get them out & sold & your Cotton to market in time to meet such short engagements we are all well, business quite dull - haven't engaged in business for myself yet but will in a few days -

Sold your first Cotton some time ago for 30¢ & the last three bales for 37¢ - say nothing about that - Will be up in a week or two
