I have this day sold to G. H. Mosely
a Negro Slave named Cissley, aged
sixteen years, for the sum of Four
Hundred ~~and~~ Dollars to me in
hand paid, I hereby warrant the
said Negro Cissley to be a Slave
for life and warrant her to be sound
and healthy in Body & mind, and
forever warrant and defend the title
to the said Negro, to the said
Mosely & his heirs forever Given
under my hand and seal this
30th day of September 1843
