I am feeling very well  
and happy to-night listening  
to the sounds of the big guns.

It is a constant rumbling  
and roaring. To-day being

clear we saw many aeroplanes

in the sky and were visited

I have trained we saw  
the enemy's baggage hit on  
the crest just in front  
of us then it advanced  
until it was nearer us  
but stopped before any of  
the projectiles came far  
enough to hit us.

I received the fine  
pencils sent by Dr. and  
Mrs. Clegg. They were enjoyed



and I still have some left.

Mother, you never did write me  
just how we came out in  
the cotton last fall. Thanked to Daddy  
for paying the Mus. Col notes for  
me as I had entirely forgotten  
them.

I am expecting lots of mail  
from home and especially, you  
and Sister. Give my love to all.
