I have been assigned to a French Battery that is on the front and am learning very much real artillery. of have so far been with the division of ar groupe commander who is in charge of 3 Batteries. So you see we live very high buil one of the officers. only can speak a little english So most of our conversation is in French but even get I do not speak it fleuntly. My orderly will arrive to-day with 2. saddle horses for me. I sent him back

to my buttery, yesterday to get a horse. I hope to go back to my battery that is also at the front in a month. I like The life fre up here. Inst night everything was quiet until half fast two and in one second it sounded like every Thing broke loose and the Germand made an attack but without any success what ever Give my love to all and remember how much of love you my dear Mother your devoted son Lieut aller Blans A A Bet 6. 149 M ZA.
