Dear Brother,

Father
received yours of the 1st April a few
days ago, in reply to which you
will find enclosed the right half
of two hundred & fifty dollars the
left of which I will send you by
next mail, your letter was some
time coming and we had to stir
around a little to get the money, but
I am in hopes it will reach
you in time to answer your purpose,
acknowledge the receipt as soon as
you receive it - We are all well,
I have been expecting a letter from you
for some time but it has not come
yet, why don't you write? We have
received our Spring stock & have been
quite busy for some time, times are getting

rather dull though just now - Mr. Cathay
received a letter from John Morgan "in Texas"
a few days ago he said Uncle Bushels
family were well, I have not a word
~~of going to write~~ I guess you are very
willing to hear that as it would be
some trouble if I had news & would write
it for you to read it - I will send you
the left half in a day or so -

The country is quite healthy the prospects
for a crop is rather gloomy - but I am
not able to say how it will turn out.
