Details of Operation

This registry contains a list of prospective candidates interested in a teaching or administrative position in one of the 14 Southern states which comprise the SREB region where they will be in a racial minority. The fourteen - state SREB region includes Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia and West Virginia.

- 1. Individuals are eligible for this service if they have received or will receive a graduate degree during the period August 1970 August 1975. Colleges and universities, both private and public, are eligible to request the cost free registry if they are located in one of the fourteen Southern states of SREB.
- 2. Individual applicants need only complete and return the official application form which will be mailed upon written request.
- 3. A request from institutions desiring the service should include the name and title of the person who is to receive the registry.
- 4. Following this April release, the Registry will be up-dated and distributed during the months of May, November, January, and March. Individuals will be required to notify the Faculty Data Bank if they wish to remain in the active file.
- 5. The Institute staff will not participate in any negotiations between institutions resulting from services rendered by the Faculty Data Bank.

This registry is designed to provide a brief description of prospective employees. A complete vitae and application of any registrant will be forwarded upon request to institutions for further employment consideration.
