This Contract is made by and between
B H Wade & Henry Whitney
Said Wade agrees to rent to the
said Henry Whitney all of the land the
said Henry Whitney worked last year
Said Henry Whitney agrees to pay
for same four (4) Bales of
Cotton weighing four hundred
and twenty five (425) lbs each
Said Cotton to be delivered at
the Prospect Hill Gin on or
before the 1st day of November
A D 1888, in good merchant-
able order. Signed this
the 11th day of January
