three hundred dollars in full consideration for one  
negro girl slave known by the name of Ester  
three years old which slave or girl I warrant  
to be sound in body and mind and do further  
warrant and defend the right of the same from  
myself my heirs and assigns and from all  
other claims or claims what ever against  
said girl unto said Louisa Callaway and to her  
heirs and assigns for ever to have and to hold all  
rights and titles there unto given under my hand  
and seal this day and date above written signed in the  
presence of us
