Sunday Mar 10th 1918

My dearest Mother,

I am out of the hospital to-day and feel very good but will not leave until to-morrow. I hope you get my cable-gram O.K. There are very few of my old friends around so I walked up to an officer's rest room here in the Y.M.C.A. and found a nice place to sit by the fire, and write, or read and there is a box of American apples here with a sign above "Help Yourself." So I have helped myself. The boys are showing up well. Every time the Infantry hears that the 149th is behind them they are at once ready to fight.
