This morning received the cifne af Life" and one copy of The Mississiffic Collegian. Gesterday received pours of kan, 14 th and a fruit cake from and Jennie seut in Jovember au feeling fine to -day, Knot returned from a visit to front line Treucher.

One of the lieutenant of my Battery wounded here to-day but it is not serious. Will only take three months in hospital. He is on sauce arrigament as of aux and came over to see me, yesterday afternoon spending the aftermosnas from showing him my location. It was a fine time

to receive the cake and of ane here with the freuch. It was . not very dry either, keft well. Mother will not write longer to-night as of have just finished a letter of thanks to Mr. Skipwith for magazine sent. me and one to any funie. Osite more net hime.
