Friday Mar. 15th & 16th 1918

My dearest Mother.

I am occupying a neat little dug out all by my self and quite a ways from where the french officers are. It is the place which ^{was} occupied by apperson for several weeks and only a short distance from here was where he was wounded. He is getting along fine now. I am going

to see him Sunday if possible.

There is a young french
officer here who speaks very
good english.

I dont think I will be

here much longer. am still
reading the papers sent
me and they are a great
pleasure. So please send
me more.

The raids on Paris are very
bad. I hope they will soon
be stopped.

Mother, I will close this note
as it is just to let you know
that I am real well.
