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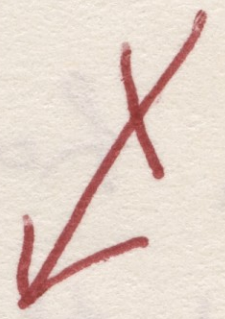

are working cash register

Mr. Bounds said ~~was~~ no objection
to having ~~the~~ qualified blacks at any
position, cashier or otherwise, but at
this point there is no vacancy - it seems
that all things ~~that~~ ~~can be done is~~ that and
be suggested as for qualified blacks to apply
for positions. Have any blacks applied?

Bounds said 80% of cafeteria employees
are black: black butchers & supervisors;
chef is a Negro - cafeteria, he says, has
many high sch students, mostly black, &
blv he said.

Bounds was hostile in his conversation
and profane in his speech. I am not convinced
that he would readily hire Negroes ~~as~~ as
cashiers or other front line positions. Part of

his hostility manifested itself in charging
that the students don't want to work
that they work over in his department in
contrast with the loafing that he implied
goes on in other depts throughout the University.
He said in other depts ^{employed} students sit on their
benches " & quoted that with non-working
