## Valuable Lands for Sale.

In obedience to a decree of the Court of Equity of Rutherford County, I will expose to sale on the premises, or Saturday the eighth day of January next, all the lands belonging to the Estate of the late Richard Planton dec'd. — The sale will commence with the offer of the old plantation, or and near the mouth of Shoal Creek. It contains about 405 acres, some of which is of fine quality, and upon which there is now a good Grist Mill — the only one, and the only situation for one, in a large land prop above neighborhood. —

The sale of the other lands, comprising three contiguous tracts, containing an aggregate of about six hundred acres, will follow, at the late family residence on the Post Road, as soon as the above has been disposed of. These afford some excellent meadow and quite good upland, advantageously situated for mercantile or other public purposes, on the great Post Road between Sealedale and Spartanburg Court House. — A survey will be made and the exact quantity & situation of each tract will be shown on the day of sale.

A credit twelve months will be given, the purchaser entering into bond <sup>with</sup> approved security. —
