



This deed, made this eighteenth day of December in the
Year eight hundred and fifty six, between Roscoe B. Heath
and Elizabeth M, his wife, of Richmond, Virginia, of the first part,
and Jacob Thompson, of the State of Mississippi, of the second part, Witnesseth:
That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the
sum of Twenty five hundred dollars (\$2500) to them in hand
paid or secured to the said party of the second part,
have sold and conveyed, and do hereby sell and convey
unto the said party of the second part, the following four
slaves, to wit: Eliza Jane, Jane, John, and Anna, which
were the maiden property of the said Elizabeth M
Heath, who was Elizabeth Mason, And the said
parties of the first part covenant and bind with the
said party of the second part, that they will
warrant and defend the title to the said slaves
herein conveyed, to the said party of the second
part, against all persons whatsoever.

I, James D. Walyburton, Judge of the
District Court of the United States for the Eastern
District of Virginia
do certify, that Roscoe Heath and Elizabeth M.
his wife, whose names are signed to the writing
above, bearing date on the 18th December 1856, personally
appeared before me, in the City of aforesaid, and ~~ad-~~
sincerely acknowledged, that they had signed, held
and delivered the said writing, as their act and deed.
And the said Elizabeth M. Heath, the wife of the
said Roscoe Heath, being examined by me
privily and apart from her said husband, and
having the writing aforesaid fully explained to her,
acknowledged, that she had signed, held and delivered
the same, as her voluntary act and deed, freely, without
any fear, threat or compulsion of her husband,
and that she does not wish to retract it.
