Apr 6th 1918.

My dearest Mother,

I am very well to-day.
I hear that we have
some mail back at the
horse lines and I hope
I am included in the
batch. It is a steady
grind now but I like
it fine. The Capt, Robbins, St
Ennis and I are together
now so we can relieve
each other and have

a few minutes rest
in the mean time. At
present my home is about
30 ft. under the surface
and we live by the
light of candles. I like
the work fine. It will
be a pleasure unexpressable
to live again in a clean
home after the war.

Last night was the
first in 6 nights that
I had my clothes off

even to sleep. But it
is a life I am glad
to have lived. I often
remember the times when
you have said to me,
that I ought not to
worry about little things.
I can appreciate more
than ever your love
for me and I love
you to-day as I have
always and even more.
I love you far more
than I love any girl
that has ever come
into my life. So you
can readily see that
I have not yet found
my better-half. Although
you may at one time thought
that I had.

Much love and no news
is good news for there may
come weeks that I will
not be able to get letters
mailed.

I will close for this time dear
mother of mine!
