Biographical Note

Borden Deal was born in Pontotoc, Miss., in 1922. He worked as a firefighter, at a lumber mill, harvesting wheat, and at assorted other occupations before deciding to dedicate himself to writing full time in 1956. He wrote numerous short stories that appeared in national publications. Deal also authored twenty-one novels, including *Walk Through The Valley* (1956) and *The Tobacco Men* (1965). He died of a heart attack in Sarasota, Fla., in 1985.
