I have this day sold to Mr Charles Mitchell a negro
Woman by the name of Mary about twenty two years
old. I warrant the title of said woman & that she is a
slave for life. her health in a general way is good
she is subject to spells when a sleep and has been for
the last fifteen years causes unknown to me. I have
sold her for nine hundred dollars. Three or four hun-
-dred dollars less than I would have taken for her
if she was not subject to those spells. I therefore
do not warrant her health given under my hand
This 23rd day of November 1859 P. Hines
