My dear Brother,

It is very cold this morning and especially so for spring-time. But the beautiful sunshine will be out in full blaze after another day probably. I received the fine box of Almonds and Chocolate also the spearmint gum all from Aunt Agnes. It was fine and I have over half on hand yet for a hard day possibly.

After all Brother, war is not as bad as it is described. There come a few hard times but I like the real life up here very much. I had much rather be here than anywhere else now.

Another Capt has been added to the battery for instruction and he (Capt. J. M. Dickinson) Capt. Robbins and I are the only officers at this position. He also is a fine man. So I am in very good company. Capt. Dickinson has a beautiful wife and baby back home. It seems hard when so many men leave home, ~~that~~ ^{who} are the support of families, that ~~my~~ my case is a minor one because Daddy is there to take care of you, Sister and the boys.

I have written to both Coz. Fletch and Coz. Clara in the last few days. Give my love to all my family and friends.
