Know all Men, by these Presents,

That I, J. H. Northwest of the County of Burton and State
of Kentucky, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred
Dollars current money of Kentucky, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is

hereby acknowledged, have this day bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto

Plant or Mitchell of the County of Polk and State of Mississippi, a

certain NEGRO Woman SLAVE, named Lucy about thirty

five years of age, of a Black complexion; which Negro I warrant sound, both in

body and mind, and a Slave for life; and the title do and will forever warrant and defend, by these presents.

in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and 59
