Know all men by these presents that
whereas at the November Term 1859 of the Probate
Court of Pontotoc County of the State of
Mississippi a decree was granted to the
under signed as administrator of the Estate
of James McKunean deceased to sell certain
Negro Slaves belonging to the Estate of
said decedant and whereas said sale
was ordered to be upon twelve months
credit from the day of sale now therefore
and in consideration of the premises and
the sum of Four Thousand

dollars bid by C. G. Mitchell &
J. H. Plant - I have this day granted bargain
sold and by these presents do grant bargain
and sell to the said C. G. Mitchell & J. H. Plant
certain negro slaves to wit - Emeline a
Black woman age about thirty two years old and her four
Children - wit Margent age about three years and about ten
Fanny age about three and Martha age about eight
months old

To have and to hold to the only proper use
of said C. G. Mitchell & J. H. Plant ~~their~~ heirs
executors administrators and assigns to the
extent and that extent only which I
can by virtue of said administration
grant bargain sell and convey,
in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal
this the 23 day of March 1860
