For and in consideration of the use
of all the land I worked on the Pros-
pect Hill Plantation (during the year 1889)
for one year, I do this day agree
to pay as rent for same to B. H. Waddy
three and one half Bales of Cotton
weighing four hundred and twenty
five pounds each to the bale, and
to deliver the said three and one half
bales of Cotton at the Prospect
Hill Gin on or before the first
day of November 1890 in market-
able condition, Signed this
the 23rd day of January A.D. 1890
