land I worked on the Prospect Hill Plantation (Except  
the part around the Old Gin) for the year 1890  
I do this day agree to pay as rent for same to  
B. H. Wade four Bales of Cotton weighing four  
hundred and ~~thirty~~ ~~five~~ pounds each to  
the bale, and said four bales to be delivered  
at the Prospect Hill Gin on or before the  
first day of November 1890 in marketable  
condition.

day of January A. D. 1890
