## **Biographical Note**

Playwright and screenwriter Beth Henley was born in Jackson, Miss. in 1952. Many of her works are set in Mississippi and feature southern characters and themes. Perhaps her best-known play is *Crimes of the Heart*, for which she won the Pulitzer Prize for Drama in 1981. *Crimes of the Heart* also earned Henley a Tony award nomination, and was adapted as a film of the same title in 1986. Her other works include *The Wake of Jamey Foster* (1983); *The Miss Firecracker Contest* (1985); *The Debutante Ball* (1991); *Family Week* (2000); *Ridiculous Fraud* (2006); and others.
