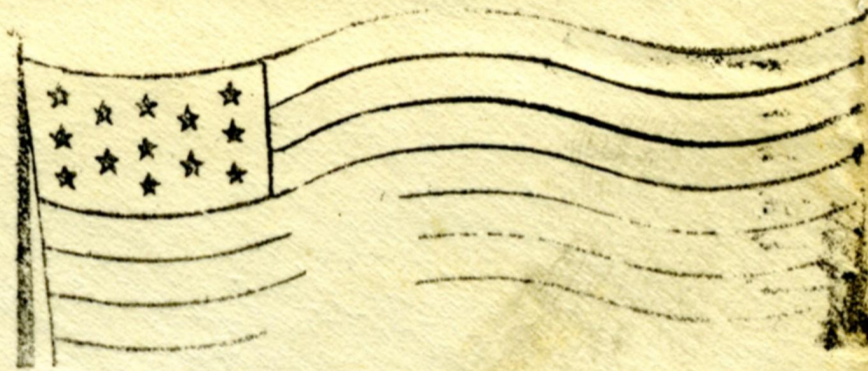
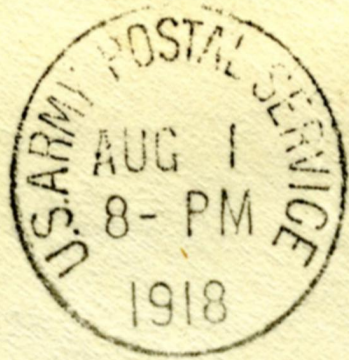

My dearest Mother,

I have just finished my classes for to-day but, that by no means, says I have finished what I have to do for I have to prepare for to-morrow. But I feel much better now, than I did last week. Next course will be easy for me but I had much rather be with the Battery.

Saturday I got a new uniform and it fits real well it is the first time I have been able to be at a place long enough to get one. Think I will get several while here so that I will be well fixed. I sent my June pay home and the government should send Daddy a check for it soon. If not received soon then let me know.

I have a room-mate now and
he is a very fine man. Capt Montgomery
is his name and he is the acting
Battalion Commander, of the outfit
I am now instructing.

I tried to send a cable gram
through ^{to you} yesterday but had to go to so
much red tape to get one that I decided
to let ~~the case~~ it go until another time.

Hope to have some mail real soon.
