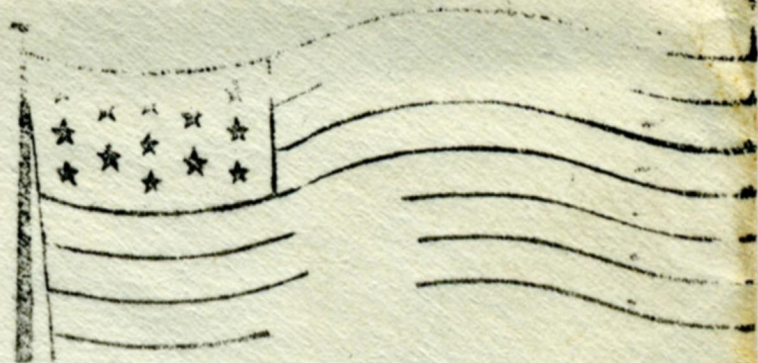

My dearest Mother,

I am very fine to-night. In fact I seem to have regained my pep again and am very interested in my work. To-morrow I will give the officers of this Battalion an examination on the course we have had. After all this is not such a bad job and I learn more in teaching than when I took the course myself. Because I have to grasp it well enough to make others see it. These men here have just been through Ft. Sill, and they seem very much to prefer the data and information that I am

interesting. Next course will be even
much easier for me to take through
than this one for I am gaining
much ^{that is} valuable to me as an
instructor.

How are the crop now? Will
be very glad to hear from Daddy
at any time that he can write
to me.
