My dearest Mother,

Have just finished my mid-day repas and returned to my office. To-night the french mission is giving a grand banquet but I think it will be my luck to be out here and look after the school. But I went to several banquets given by the french when I was at Saumur last Oct. and

November. so I am not
caring so much about
this one.

If I continue to hold
this job down it will
be the middle of January
before I get away from
here. Then I have no
idea where I will go
maybe I will then
be a casual officer and
sent home. That would
certainly please me very

much as I would like to be
there to start in at the
1st of the new year. I drew
my mileage to-day for my
trip a few days ago and it came
to \$79⁰⁰. So you see I had
a very nice trip. I was
just about to get in on
a leave when the Colonel
gave me this job. He is
