EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

With the appointment of the first AICPA Minority Recruitment and Equal Opportunity Committee in 1969, the AICPA Council formally launched a national program to integrate the accounting profession by:

Assisting minority men and women to prepare themselves for professional careers in accounting and graduate from college.

Encouraging public accounting firms and other business organizations to take action to recruit and promote minority men and women.

The AICPA publishes this annual study to provide current information on the supply of minority accounting graduates, the employment of those graduates and the employment of minorities in major and minority public accounting firms. The information for minority employment and placement of minority graduates is taken from responses to questionnaires, which were in the same form as the tables presented in this report. Requests were mailed to those firms having more than 25 AICPA members, 211 this year, and to 203 minority firms. Requests were also mailed to 67 traditionally black and minority colleges and universities. The third section of the report presents schedules by individual and school of the AICPA scholarship awards in July and December 1989, of \$434,000 to 596 students.

Although recent national studies indicate increases in minority college enrollments, minority students continue to be underrepresented on college campuses and the number of Black males enrolled has declined.

In 1976 minorities represented a minimal 4.0 percent of the 56,336 professionals in the survey of major accounting firms. By 1989 minorities still represented only 6.1 percent of the 113,234 professionals in the surveyed firms and Black representation has declined from 1.8 percent in 1976 to 1.3 percent in 1989.

Minority men and women are a rich source of talent for the accounting profession. It is important that minorities have a true opportunity to succeed. While this report indicates some progress, the Committee continues to urge all members of the profession to provide equal opportunity by:

Participation in career programs for minority middle school and high school students to generate a growing interest in a college education and a career as a certified public accountant.

Expansion of minority recruitment efforts for internships and entry level employment by making the decision to provide opportunities.

Increasing minority upward mobility and promotion by providing a climate of fairness and opportunity which stimulates professional growth and achievement.

Our continued efforts in providing equal opportunity can only benefit the profession.
