Mar. 1<sup>st</sup> 1919

My dear Mother,

I just a note  
to let you know  
that I am all  
O.K. It is time  
for dinner but

morning inspection

There are two ladies  
of the Y.M.C.A. here now.  
But they haven't yet

before we go home

so we can cut  
out some of the  
expressions, often heard

all the regiment except  
the two batteries <sup>here</sup> are moving  
to other towns. Hadley  
moved in with  
me and we are  
a little crowded but  
he gave his room to  
the ladies.

portance and dinner  
is ready.
