Dearest Rivers,

We've had a
busy day and are
just about ready to
fall in bed. Sunday
is "our" day so
we enjoy every
minute of it. I had
hoped to be off on
Saturday afternoon
but since that's im-
possible we have to
do all our sight-
seeing on Sunday.

We went to Church
this morning and had
planned to go out
to the Franciscan
Monastery this after-
noon. We ate dinner
and started out but
when we passed the
White House there was
such a mob that we
got off to see what
was going on. There is
a path directly across
Pennsylvania Avenue
from the South
Entrance of the White

House and it was
packed with people.
They had a broad-
casting station set
up and people were
just sitting or standing
there looking across
at the White House for
some signs of news.
We stayed there from
2:00 until 6:00 and
when we left the
crowd was thicker
than ever.

Tonight the reports

are more confusing than
ever so I hope we
won't have to wait much
longer to hear that it's
all over.

Try to write me
now and then - I
miss you.

Don't having a
big time up here and
getting quite a thrill
out of the whole thing
but will be so glad
to get home again.
