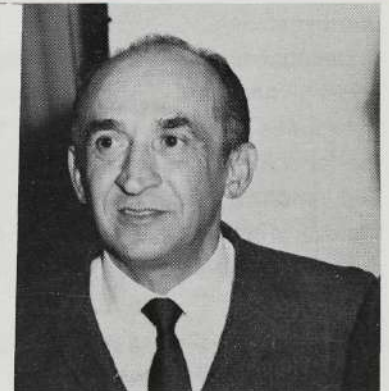


In Mexico City...
