Dear Dr. Silver:

Many thanks for Mississippi in the Confederacy which arrived this morning. It served to remind me I haven't sent the clippings of the Jan. 15 tables showing white-Negro school costs in Mississippi.

I checked in circulation two weeks ago, but the few people I know in that department were out of pocket. Today they were in. So I'm sending you under separate cover eight tear sheets of Page 24. The story appeared in the Mississippi two-star and three-star editions and the Arkansas two-star editions.

There are about six other papers on file in our morgue which you are welcome to have in six months.

I've started teaching Pol. Sci. 221 (National Government) at Memphis State. There are 30 in the class, although one student said he would have to drop the course "because he was already taking three other classes where you have to think, and he didn't have time for another one."
