CONSTITUTION.

Add at end of Article 4, Section 1 :

“By vote of the members at the Annual Meeting the offices of Secretary and Treasurer for the ensuing year may be combined.”

In Article II, Section 2-A, of the Constitution, for the words “at least three years previous” to read the words “at least three years next previous.”

BY-LAWS.

In Article I add a Section 14: Committee on Journal—The duties of the Committee on Journal shall be to supervise the publication of the Journal of Accountancy and to direct its policy on behalf of the American Association and in conjunction with the Directors of the Accountancy Publishing Company.
