WITNESS :

Article III, Section 5, of the By-Laws provides as follows :

MEMBERS-AT-LARGE.

“SECTION 5. Each Fellow at-Large, who was a member of this Association at the date
of the passage of these laws, shall be entitled to cast one vote, either personally or by duly
authorized proxy, upon each question which shall properly be brought before any meeting
of the Association, and for the election of officers thereof. If, however, he elects to so vote,
he shall not be entitled to representation for voting purposes as a Society member, and no
State or District Society shall be assessed by the Association on account of his membership
in said State or District Societies.”

56 Pine Street, New York City, may be inserted as the Proxy.
