DR SILVER:

YOU MIGHT BE INTERESTED IN THE ENCLOSED LEAFLETS, WHICH WERE DISTRIBUTED IN THE STUDENT UNION MORE THAN A WEEK BEFORE THE RIOTS HERE. (THE DAY FOLLOWING ISSUE OF A PAPER CALLING FOR STUDENTS TO FOLLOW ROSS.)

THE EXISTENCE OF ANY OPPOSITION TO BARNETT AND TO VIOLENCE AT THE UNIVERSITY HAS BEEN IGNORED ALMOST TOTALLY BY THE PRESS, AS YOU KNOW.

SUCH OPPOSITION DID EXIST, AND NOT ALL OF IT WAS SILENT. THE COUNSEL WAS OBVIOUSLY IGNORED, HOWEVER.

THESE MIGHT STILL BE OF SOME USE WITH THE PRESS AND MIGHT HELP CREATE A BETTER IMAGE OF A RESPONSIBLE STUDENT BODY THAN NOW EXISTS. IF YOU FIND NO WAY TO USE THEM, THEY ARE AT LEAST MINOR HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS.

APPROXIMATELY 400 WERE PRINTED BUT I BELIEVE SOME OF THEM WERE GATHERED UP AND THROWN AWAY BY "ROSS-IS-RIGHTERS"
