Dear Professor Silver:

My friend and Ohio Colleague, Harris Warren, has suggested that you may be interested in a position in the University of Toledo. We plan to name a professor of history who will teach not more than six hours per semester and three hours in a summer term and who will serve as chairman of the Graduate Study Committee of the College of Arts and Sciences.

We are in the process of building here, both in the Department and the College of Arts and Sciences. We now grant the master's degree in history and in most of the other departments of the College. Our next step is to be the doctorate in a few departments including history. The Chairman of the Graduate Study Committee will be responsible for planning and directing the graduate work.

For a 12 month contract this position will pay approximately \$15,000. There will be a vacation period of five weeks.
