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## STATE RECIPROCITY PROVISIONS

All states issue reciprocal certificates to CPA's of other states. Provisions relating to the issuance of these certificates have been tabulated here based on the replies to a questionnaire sent to all state boards in April 1961.

#### SPECIAL COMMENTS

#### Colorado

Question 4 -- As long as applicant has met the requirements of this state at the time of application.

# Connecticut

Question 5 -- Continuous period of one year immediately prior to date of application.

7 -- Unless he is the managing partner of office in state.

#### Delaware

Question 5 -- If applicant is a resident - 12 consecutive months (in Delaware) preceding date of application. If applicant is a non-resident - 2 consecutive years.

7 -- Unless devoting 50% of his normal working time to such public accounting practice in Delaware.

## Indiana

Question 2 -- But must be a member of the AICPA.

## Iowa

Question 3 -- If applicant has been in continuous practice under original certificate for at least seven years.

#### Kansas and Kentucky

Question 4 -- As long as applicant has met the requirements of this state at the time of application

## Maryland

Question 5 -- Only as an alternative to graduation from a school of accounting.

Question 6 -- Must intend to establish if granted certificate.

Question 9 -- If firm is composed entirely of Maryland CPAs.

# Nebraska

Question 8 -- Must be in practice in state.

## New Jersey

Question 5 -- Three years public accounting with CPA.

## New York

Question 4 -- As long as applicant has met the requirements of this state at the time of application.

#### Oregon

Question 5 -- Two years in the office of a CPA or PA provided they meet the other experience requirements of this state.

#### Pennsylvania

Question h -- As long as applicant has met the requirements of this state at the time of application.

Question 5 -- Must have been in public accounting for at least 2 years since the issuance of original certificate.

#### Tennessee

Question 6 -- If a partner in a firm having office in state, residency is not required.

Question 2 -- Temporary permits are issued to applicants for reciprocal certificates who do not have one year residency requirement to receive certificate.

# Florida

Question 2 -- Extensions are permitted.

# Iowa

Question 2 -- Temporarily usually means one engagement only.

No time limit.

#### Missouri

Question 2 -- A particular contract.

# Michigan

Question 2 -- For one or two assignments.

#### Nevada

Question 2 -- Upon application until approval or denial of reciprocity certificate.

#### North Carolina

#### Question

1 and 8 -- N. C. engagements undertaken by nonresident CPAs must be done by or in charge of a CPA.

## Texas

Question 4 -- Foreigners with equal of CPA permitted to practice temporarily under titles held in their own countries.

Question 8 -- CPA permitted to open office and practice individually when no partner is Texas CPA. Cannot conduct practice in name of partnership or use plural designation "CPAs".
