No-Smoking: It's the Law

The article, "Restrictions on Smoking" in the March 11th edition of <u>Inside</u> included a reprint of the Institute's New York office no smoking policy. It also addressed one of the most frequently asked questions, "Is smoking allowed in the restroom?" Even though the answer to that question was "no", we have received several complaints that staff members continue to use the restrooms as smoking lounges. New York State Law Prohibits Smoking In Restrooms.

Smoking and no smoking signs are prominently displayed throughout the Institute's offices. We ask that <u>all</u> AICPA employees respect the rights of both the non-smoker and the smoker. Employees, who do not have a private office, are permitted to smoke <u>only</u> in the designated smoking areas of the cafeteria.

Employees who violate the Institute's no-smoking policy are subject to discipline. Questions regarding the policy and/or its implementation and enforcement should be directed to Human Resources.
