Zoya Khaldeyeva - Data Entry Operator - Membership Administration. Zoya joins the Institute full-time after temping in our Membership Administration Department.

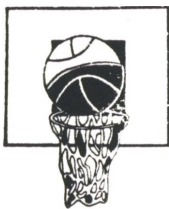
