After more than 20 years of being the Management Advisory Services (MAS) Division, the Board has voted to change the name to the Management Consulting Services (MCS) Division in recognition of the recent issuance of the first Statement on Standards for Consulting Services. The new name should be used in all Institute publications and correspondence.

The MCS Division is the home of the Management Consulting Services Executive Committee, one of the Institute's Senior Technical Committees and the Management Consulting Services Section, one of the four Institute membership sections that was formed in 1986 as the Membership Division for Management Advisory Services. The Division's newsletter is also changing its name to The CPA Management Consultant.
