Do you realize, that if it wasn't for a man named Luca Pacioli the AICPA might not be here? We hope that's a reason to love Luca Pacioli because, since he published the principles of double entry bookkeeping in 1494, he has been known as the "Father of Modern Accounting". This year being the 500th anniversary of the Franciscan monk's work, "Summa de Arithmetica, Geometria, Proportioni et Proportionalita", is cause for a celebration!

In the spirit of commemoration of the hero's contributions to the accounting profession, we have designated Friday, August 19, as "Luca Pacioli Day" at the Institute. A number of fun events will be held.
