If you have already submitted your entry form without specifying a preference, we will contact you if your name is selected.

All PCs include a monitor, keyboard and base unit. The 286 machines have between 640 KB and 1 MB of memory and a 20 MB hard drive. The XT machines have 640 KB of memory and a 20 MB hard drive.
