Bookmobile**

The Jersey City Public Library provides regular Bookmobile service at a number of locations. Stops are made every other week.

The changing book collection aboard the Bookmobile offers a wide variety of reading for all ages and interests. You may borrow books, free of charge, for two weeks with no renewals. If you do not have a library card, you may get one on the Bookmobile.

The date card in the book pocket indicates the date of the Bookmobile's next visit, at which time books are due. If you fail to return your books on the due date, a one-week fine-free period follows, during which books may be returned without charge to the Bookmobile or any Library unit. Once the free period is up, fines are assessed at the rate of 10 cents per day.

Following is the Bookmobile schedule for September through December at locations within walking distance:

- * Exchange Place - Wednesdays, September 7, 21; October 5, 19; November 2, 16, 30; December 14, 28 from 12:00 - 1:15 p.m.
- * Christopher Columbus Drive at Harborside - Mondays, September 12, 26; October 10, 24; November 7, 21; December 5, 19 from 12:00 - 1:15 p.m.
